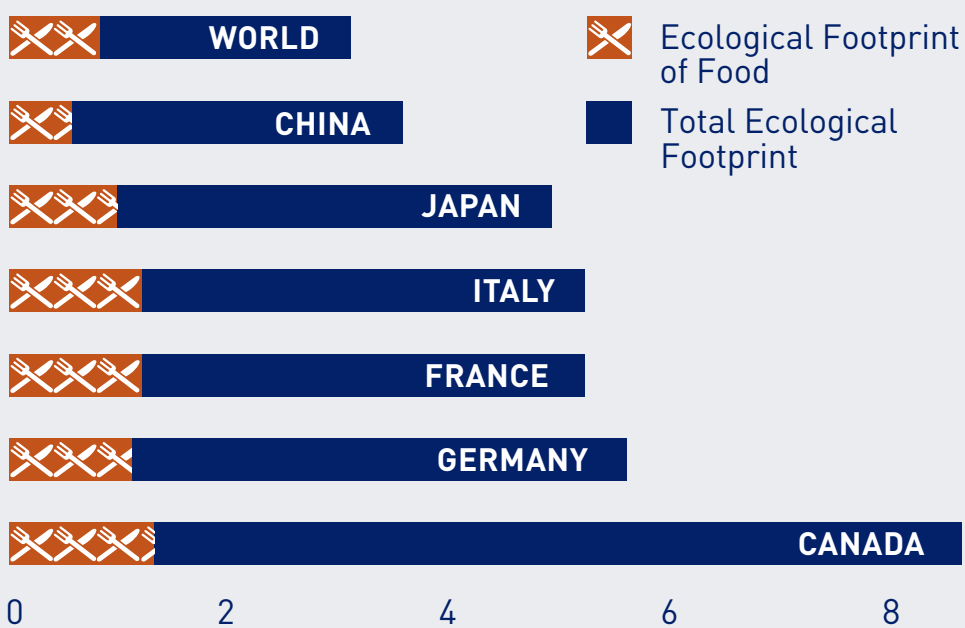
TO SUPPORT **HUMANITY'S DEMAND ON NATURE**

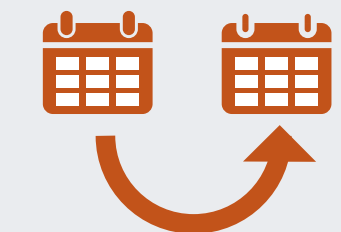
